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## IMPLEMENTATION

## INTENT

*The Year 9 course strengthens pupils' grammatical understanding further. The topic of "my world" consolidates the grammatical structures covered in previous years, before pupils learn to talk about their future plans using the future tense and modal verbs. Pupils then discover how to use the imperfect tense to say what things used to be like, and compare and contrast the past and the present. By the end of Year 9, pupils are well equipped to begin the GCSE course.*
