INTENT In Year 9 Polish we introduce pupils to Polish phonics and enable them to communicate about themselves, their family and friends and their home. We develop vocabulary related to life in small villages and the big cities. This year we also consolidate the present tense and introduce past and future tenses, to enable students to communicate about events using three-time frames. The topics of house and home, town and village encourage pupils to communicate in greater depth, giving opinions and reasons and using a range of connectives. The later topics equip pupils with the skills they will need at the beginning of the GCSE course.
