

Lent at BGN

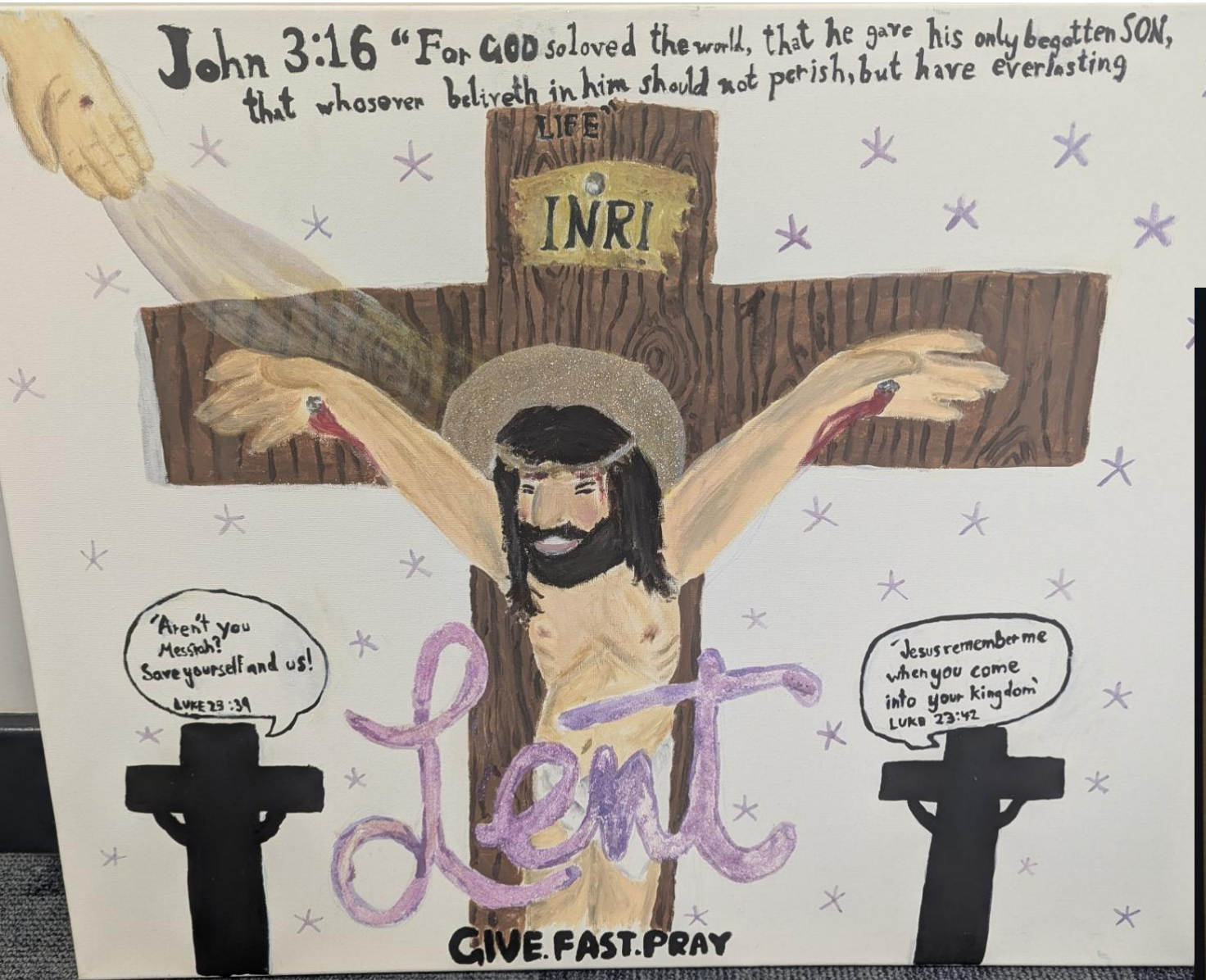

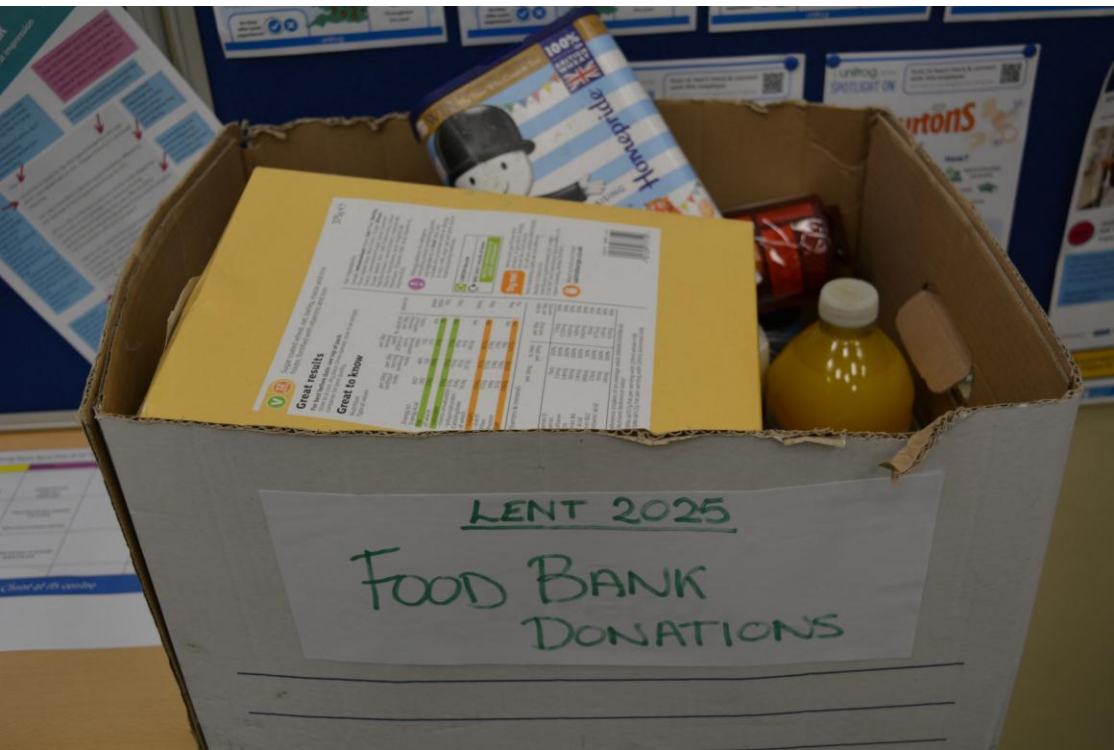

Do not take on the bitterness, see the power that sharing that love can do for others



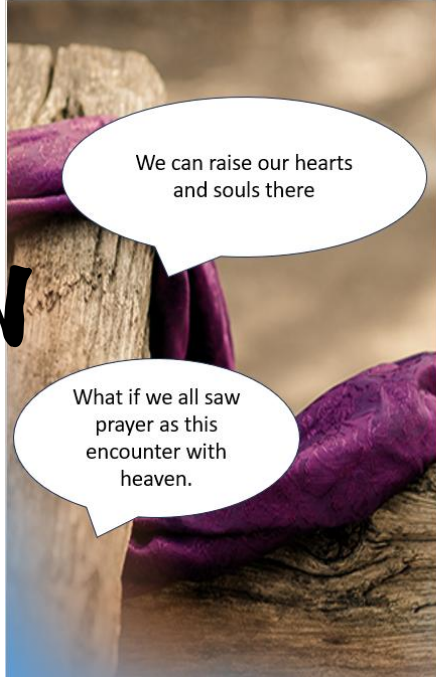
