Dear Parent/Guardian

As mentioned in our earlier communication, we have a number of staff who are absent due to having tested positive for Covid-19. We have sought advice and continue to maintain as safe an environment as we possibly can in school.

Unfortunately, we have had to take the decision to partially close the school for **all Year 9 students tomorrow**, **Tuesday 22 March 2022**. All work will be set remotely using the homework function on the VLE and students should be familiar with how to access this. BGN remains open for all other year groups and your child should continue to attend as normal, if they remain well. All students and staff, regardless of year group, should remain vigilant regarding Covid-19.

Obviously we will continue to keep the situation under review and it is possible that we may need to close BGN for other year groups in the coming days. We will endeavour to ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum for individual year groups. We will, of course, prioritise support for exam groups.

What to do if your child develops symptoms of Covid-19 or tests positive for Covid-19 The main symptoms of Covid-19 are a new, continuous cough, or a high temperature, or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

If your child develops symptoms of Covid-19, they should get a PCR test via Get a free PCR test to check if you have coronavirus (COVID-19) - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) or by calling 119 and remain at home at least until the result is known. If the test is positive, stay at home and follow the guidance COVID-19: people with COVID-19 and their contacts - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk) and inform BGN School of the result in the usual manner by contacting our Attendance Officer.

If your child has a positive LFD test please report this test <u>Report a COVID-19 rapid lateral flow test result - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)</u>. They should stay at home and follow the guidance <u>COVID-19: people with COVID-19 and their contacts - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)</u>. A confirmatory PCR test is not required.

How to stop Covid-19 spreading

- Wear a face covering when it is hard to stay away from other people particularly indoors, or in crowded places
