Dear Year 13 Students and Parents/Guardians

In order to support you to prepare for your final exams, we would like to offer you the opportunity to select up to five study periods over the two-week timetable in which you can undertake independent study at home. Our expectation is that this time is used for focused research, writing or revision and is not seen as 'free time'. The purpose of the pass is for you to undertake sustained and focused work at home and you should only consider applying for one if your recent report showed a good attitude to learning.

You can nominate up to five such periods which you must agree with your teachers. Before you can consider applying for a privilege pass you must ensure that you are completely up to date with your EPQ, and passes will only be authorised if your EPQ teacher has signed your application to say that they support it. We will monitor progress throughout the year and if it is felt that you would work better in school where you can be supported, we will decline your application.

We also require that you have the agreement of your Parents/Guardians and request that you complete the form on the reverse which should be returned to Mrs Russell to be confirmed by Mrs O'Donnell. Please note that this Privilege Pass is a privilege and not a right. It may be refused or withdrawn if subject teachers feel that you do not benefit from working at home.

If you wish to apply for a Privilege Pass, please complete the form on the reverse side of this page and identify which study periods you would like to nominate. You will then need to ask your EPQ teacher, subject teachers, and form tutor to sign to say they support your application. We will then confirm when you can start to use your pass, until then you are expected to be in school full time.
