16 – 19 Tuition Funding

What is this funding?

BGN has been allocated the amount of £4473 to be spent on supporting students in Year 13 who did not achieve a grade 5 in GCSE English and/or Maths at the end of year 11 and who are underachieving by in one of their A level study programmes. It may also be used if a student has a serious health issue which impacts on their ability to reach their full potential. We will also have regard to the needs of any students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) and / or an indicator of disadvantage. Where relevant, we have also considered the economic background of students in determining their need.

How will the funding be spent?

BGN will prioritise students (based on the above criteria) who will benefit from one-to-one tuition in at least one of their A level subjects. We will be using https://www.mytutor.co.uk/ to facilitate the program. Each student will undertake a 10 week 'near peer' one to one tutoring session supervised in the LRC. A record of identified students, the criteria they meet, and their tuition details will be recorded on a template.

Purpose

To provide one to one peer to peer tutoring to support and mentor the students identified and to help support them to close gaps in learning which may have arisen because of the long-term impact of the disruption caused to schooling during the pandemic.

Expected Impact

It is expected that students make progress on their Working at Grades based on in year teacher assessment and that their final A level grade is in line with Minimum Expected Grade based on GCSE attainment. Currently we are able to offer to 12 students as indicated below:
